After our tour, we will enjoy a four-course dinner in the delightful late afternoon of the Central Coast. We get a taste of what it must have been like to have been a guest of Mr. Hearst, for as we look around we suddenly realize we are the only guests in the park! The Hearst family is still very much in evidence here on the Central Coast, and our meal features beef grown here on the Hearst Ranch, and wines from grapes grown here in Hearst Vineyards.



After dessert, the Park motorcoach will take us the short distance to the **Cavalier Ocean Front Resort**.

Those wanting to enjoy a stroll will find a delightful sandy beach, with bonfires, just outside their door. Looking to the north we see Point Piedras, rookery to one of the largest elephant seal populations in the world.

**Saturday, August 13th:** Following breakfast, we board our motorcoach for a ride across the crest of the Coast Range and into the wine region that is Paso Robles. With its hot summers and mild winters the area is renowned for the high quality red wines it produces, with emphasis on the big four: Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Syrah, and Zinfandel. We'll enjoy a tour and tasting at two wineries, and a bite of lunch before we re-board the train at 1:38 PM.

Settled in again aboard our private railcar, we enjoy a glass of Central Coast wine as we begin our ascent of Cuesta Pass. We are treated to home-made hors d'Oeuvres and a multi-course dinner that our chef has made for us in his tiny kitchen. Timing is perfect to enjoy a spectacular sunset along the beach as our train glides on its way back to Los Angeles. Nine PM comes all too swiftly, and our journey for now is over, but we resolve to return soon to this charming piece of California!


